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The Black Student's Union of the William Penn Charter School

Statement of Purpose

We, the Black Students Union, recognize the William Penn Charter School to be a top quality school because of its high level of education, and the best available opportunities for the college-bound student. Its environment promotes better learning through such extracurricular outlets as the excellent sports program, the various clubs and societies, and an insight into the arts.

Penn Charter was founded primarily on the basis of academic education, but it also develops the character of its youth. By extending to (but not forcing on) the student body the Quaker philosophy, Penn Charter itself sets good examples of citizenship.

Because we are a minority, we strive for identity and security. We, as Blacks, relate to one another about such aspects of life that no non-Black could experience. This Black Students Union provides a self-awareness program, which is vital for any "group-confidence" to develop.

We also serve as an education process. By our existence alone, we present a different breed of culture. We, as a Black race, are generally left out from our proper places in history books (specifically those of American History). We strive for recognition as an accredited race with a rich heritage, such as the one we do so posses.

Although we come from a variety of backgrounds, no one, nor thirty-eight, nor fifty Black students can be accurately judged as representatives of an entire race.

Understand, we are not isolationists: for we feel that this type of action would only hinder our progress. But "successful integration" will demand the efforts of both partisan groups.

Our position, as a fellowship of students, is not to change the school, but to present alternative ideas to out-moded, and sometimes biased, opinions.

Our ultimate goal is to alleviate all forms of racial conflicts. For any type of successful co-existence, each faction must attempt to understand the lifestyle of the other. Through the cooperation (which is also endorsed by the Quaker philosophy) all misconceptions of the races will be wiped out and the dreams of peace and brotherhood will become realities.
